
MICHIGAN DAIRY **WORKS FOR THE WORLD**





Global demand for protein-rich dairy is rising.

Consequently, U.S. dairy exports have more than quadrupled since 2000, to \$5.5 billion in 2017. Our top five markets are Mexico (\$1.3 billion), Southeast Asia (\$690 million), Canada (\$636 million), China (\$577 million) and Japan (\$291 million).

That's good news because dairy exports create Michigan jobs and lift the state's economy.
